- Complete the attached application form.
- The exhibition is open to anyone.
- Supply a **photograph** (no disks or folders) of the **artwork** being submitted clearly marking it as your entry for the competition. Also include a maximum 1 page resume and a photo of yourself for PR opportunities.
- All Applications must be received by 5.00pm Friday November 19th, 2010. Late entries will not be accepted.
- MADEC will notify you if your application to exhibit is successful.
- Opening Launch will be held on Friday December 3rd, 2010 at 10.30am sharp. Exhibiting artists are encouraged to attend.
- Artwork must be original two or three-dimensional piece. Artwork must be no larger than 1 metre wide by 2 metres high.
- The artist should create the work interpreting the theme “**Volunteering**” and touch on their own personal exploration of the theme.
- All artwork must be supplied ready to hang or install (with wires or other fixtures already attached).
- Applicants must attach a fixed label to the back of their artwork with the artist's name, address and phone number, plus title and medium.
- Applicants accept full responsibility (and associated expenses) for packing, transport and insurance of the artwork to, from and while hung at the gallery.
- **If selected to exhibit, the artwork must be delivered to MADEC Wesley Centre between 10.30am and 5.00pm Monday, November 29th.. No exceptions can be made.**

- Artworks to be picked up Thursday December 16th, 2010. No Exceptions.
- The judges’ decision will be final.
- The MADEC Art of Volunteering prizes are not transferable. If the winning artist is unable to accept the terms and condition of the exhibition the artist will forfeit the prize.

**Artworks are encouraged to be vivid and stylistically strong as it will be used to induce a sense of welcome for visitors and viewers.**

**Artworks are also encouraged to encompass an illustrative approach and explore notions of the following theme/s:** *The Sunraysia region as a vibrant and rural heartland made up of people from diverse backgrounds who volunteer their time to support people in need, to promote a healthy sporting culture amongst our regions youth, who organise community events that instil pride and promote a positive community identity and ensure the community is supported during times of difficulty.*
