

STEP 1

Open the camera or a QR code scanner app on your smartphone.



STEP 2

Hold phone over the QR code on the MADEC Work Entitlement Card. Once it registers, details of legal work rights including visa expiry date (if relevant) along with worker's legal name and date of birth will display.



To ensure the MADEC Work Entitlement Card is valid, check that it matches the worker's other identification. Look at the photo and date of birth.

Reports detailing legal work rights, visa expiry dates, worker's legal name, date of birth, country of origin, MADEC Work Entitlement Card number and date of issue are available by request. Supplied in excel format, reports can be imported to your existing HR or CRM system. Please ask our office!

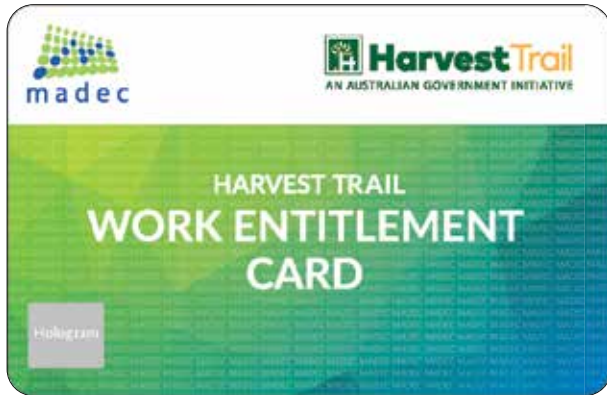

WHAT SHOULD YOUR WORKER'S CARD LOOK LIKE?



All MADEC cards are now RFID chip enabled. This means they can be integrated into existing employer timekeeping and piece rate software. Please speak to your local Harvest Office if you are interested in this feature.

FRONT OF CARD

- MADEC logo top left-hand corner
- Harvest Trail logo top right-hand corner
- Genuine, embedded MADEC hologram bottom left-hand corner
- Card is of a high-quality thickness (0.76mm)

BACK OF CARD

- QR code
- Worker's unique MADEC card number, work entitlements (refer to table below), worker's name and expiry date (expiry date will be either the visa expiry date for overseas workers or card expiry date for Australian workers)
- Worker's photograph, the date the card was printed, and MADEC logo
- Type of induction completed and date attended

Work Right Code	Work Entitlement
FULL	Unlimited – 3 months (Bridging visa)
FULL	Unlimited – (Australian resident/citizen)
WHV1, WHV2 or WHVB	8547 – 6 months with one employer
REG	8539 – Must work in regional areas only
1EMP	8107 – Employed by only one particular employer
STU	8104 & 8105 – Student 20 hours per week work limit
SPON	8577 – Full working rights, when employed by a linked SWP/PALMS approved employer
P403	403 – Full working rights, when employed by a linked SWP/PALMS approved employer

WORKER RIGHTS ARE CHECKED BEFORE MADEC WORK ENTITLEMENT CARDS ARE ISSUED.

MADEC conducts a Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) with the Department of Home Affairs in Australia, to ensure workers who hold a visa are eligible to work in Australia.

The MADEC Work Entitlement Card QR code holds personal information such as the worker's name, date of birth, visa expiry dates and MADEC's unique card number.

MADEC strongly recommends that employers conduct onsite card checks either randomly or as part of their daily practice.

Each MADEC Work Entitlement Card is unique. To ensure that a card is genuine, you can check the unique features provided in this flyer.
